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## FEE ASSESSMENT POLICY

**OBJECTIVE:** To define general fee policies and how fees will be reassessed for adding/dropping players, transfer players and injured players.

### GENERAL FEES

The fiscal year for FC Nova starts July 1<sup>st</sup> and ends June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year. While some teams may elect to train and attend tournaments prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>, payment of Club fees and team fees (referee fees, field use fees, etc.) are based on the fiscal year. Club fees must be paid in full by June 30 to avoid a \$25 service fee. In the event that a player fails to make payments towards their Club fees as defined in the Financial Agreement signed at tryouts, the “No Pay No Play” policy will be put into effect.

### ADDING PLAYERS

Players joining an FC Nova team after the initial roster signing period will pay a percentage of the total fees based on the following matrix:

\* U18 players receive no discount as they already receive a discounted Club fee as outlined in the Financial Agreement.

\*\* U19 players do not pay Club fees; as a result the only costs that they are required to pay are those needed for registration, referee fees, field usage fees, etc.

The process of adding a player to a roster after the initial roster signing period is as follows:

1. The Coach will notify the Club Registrar that a new player needs to be added to his/her roster and indicate what team and age group the player belongs to.
2. The Club Registrar will ensure that the player is not already registered with IYSA, and then add the player in Bonzi to the proper team and age group.
3. The Club Registrar will contact the player, parents and the related team manager with appropriate Club and registration information.
4. The Club Registrar will notify the Club Bookkeeper that a new player has been added.
5. The Club Bookkeeper will adjust the fees in Bonzi for the agreed upon amount send the player and parents an initial invoice and financial agreement with the adjusted fees.

## **DROPPING PLAYERS**

All Club and team fees must be paid in full for the year should a player choose not to play, desires a transfer to another team outside FC Nova or is dismissed from the team/Club for any reason during the fiscal year. However, if a player decides to leave FC Nova after signing a roster but prior to any training, the player fees may be refunded less the roster signing fee as this fee is needed to cover the Club's cost of registering the player through Bonzi and IYSA.

## **DROP DUE TO RELOCATION**

If the parent(s) or guardian(s) of a player are relocated from the Boise area for work and results in the player being unable to participate in training, games, travel, etc. for the remainder of the fiscal year then that player's fees will be reimbursed going forward from the first of the month following the relocation. For example, if a player is relocated on October 10<sup>th</sup> and is unable to return for the remainder of the fiscal year, fees will be reimbursed on a pro rata basis for the period November 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year.

## **TRANSFER PLAYERS**

Players transferring to FC Nova from another Club will be treated on a case-by-case basis.

Players transferring from FC Nova to another Club will not be eligible for reimbursement of fees based on the Financial Agreement signed at the beginning of the fiscal year. Fees owed to the Club or team when the player requests the transfer must be paid in full before the transfer will be signed.

## **INJURED PLAYERS**

If a player becomes seriously injured and is unable to participate in training, games, travel, etc. for the remainder of the fiscal year then that player's fees will be reimbursed going forward from the first of the month following the injury. For example, if a player becomes injured on October 10<sup>th</sup> and is unable to return for the remainder of the fiscal year, fees will be reimbursed on a pro rata basis for the period November 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year. Please note that an injury that does not prohibit the player from competing will not be considered for reimbursement.
